Subject Choice Discussion Opportunity: Thursday 1st September 9am – 10.45 in the main hall

If you are unsure about your subject choices and need to discuss them before making your final choice at enrolment, you can do so during this time. If you are happy with your choices, you do not need to attend and should arrive from 11am in the main hall in college by reception.

International Enrolment: Thursday 1st September arrive between 11am – 12.30pm in the main hall

This is when we officially register you as a student of Notre Dame. Please bring the originals (plus a photocopy) of:

- 1) Passport / visa
- 2) IELTS certificate (if applicable)
- 3) Latest High School Exam Results
- 4) Form IS 1 (parental authorisation form) which has been signed by your parents. You will not be allowed to take part in college activities / trips etc. without this form!

Please note that your fees must be paid before you enrol.

International Induction: Friday 2nd September 10.00am – 12.45pm This is for all new International students. It will include the signing of Learning Agreements and information about procedures within College and the UK generally. You will also receive an information pack. Please bring £15 in cash or cheque to reserve your place on the Yorkshire Coast Trip (the trip will take place on 10th September).

City Centre Sightseeing Bus Tour: Monday 5th September 10.15am This is an optional event for all new international students to get to know Leeds. You will need to bring £7.50 for the sightseeing tour. We will meet at 10.15am at the college reception, then catch the tour bus shortly after. The tour lasts for an hour with useful and interesting commentary about the area. As the ticket is valid all day, once the tour has finished you will be free to return to any of the places of interest, leaving and re-joining the bus as you wish. Please book your place with Ms Lou or Amanda during international induction.

Opening a Bank Account: Tuesday 6th September 9.30am meet in the international office. This is for students who do not have a UK bank account and would like help opening one. Please tell Amanda in advance so she can prepare a letter of introduction for you. The banks nearest to the college are: Natwest, HSBC, and Barclays. You will need your passport to open an account.

Police Registration: Thursday 8th September at 8.45am This is for those students required to register with the police. *Meet outside the entrance to Starbucks Coffee Shop, 80 Briggate in Leeds City Centre (opposite McDonalds).* Amanda will accompany you to the police station. (You will be given a city centre map and a list of nationalities required to register during your international induction session, or you can go to the college website www.notredamecoll.ac.uk and select 'international students' then 'information for new students'.)

Yorkshire Coast Trip, Saturday 10th September

A trip to the Yorkshire Coast with your fellow international students and staff. Numbers are limited so please reserve your place during the international induction if you'd like to go along. A small charge of £15 is made to cover costs for this trip; please bring this on 2nd Sept.
