


Travel Information



If you're under 19 you can apply online for a 16-19 photocard and use it to get half fare tickets on any bus or train, anytime, anywhere in West Yorkshire.

You can enjoy unlimited travel with MyDay, MyWeek and MyMonth MCard tickets for go anywhere, anytime travel on any bus within West Yorkshire.

MyDay: From just £2.25 for a day's travel on any bus, anytime, any day.

MyWeek: Go anywhere in West Yorkshire for just £9 a week .

MyMonth: Travel with a month's ticket for only £35.

The easiest way to buy MCard tickets is on the MCard Mobile App or 16-18 PhotoCard at a Bus Station Travel Centre. You can also buy the MyDay ticket on the bus with cash or a contactless card. 16-18 PhotoCards cost £5.

You will need proof of age to apply and a photo. You can also head to a Bus Station Travel Centre, they will take your photo for you, but you will still need to bring along your proof of age document.

Enrolment Checklist

1. **Original Exam Results Slip** - Please bring evidence of all exam grades achieved in Year 10 & 11 (original certificate or results slip).
2. **Your completed enrolment forms** you received through the post.
3. **£25 voluntary contribution** - Please bring £25 cash or a debit/credit card to your enrolment appointment.
4. **ID** - Passport or National Insurance Card

During Enrolment



1. Register

You will be welcomed and registered at the reception upon arrival



2. Results and ID

Your results and ID will be visually checked by one of our staff.



3. Course

You will meet a specialist subject teacher who will enrol you on your agreed courses.



4. Finance

You will be asked to make a £25 voluntary contribution.



5. Photograph

A photo will be taken of you for your College ID card.



6. Enrol


