### **Step 1**

#### **Cas Number**

Ensure that you have given full details (passport, academic certificates and school reports, UKVI IELTS certificate) to [internationalenquiries@notredamecoll.ac.uk](mailto:internationalenquiries@notredamecoll.ac.uk) to receive your CAS number for your visa, if you require one.

#### **1) Homestay**
