Remote Education Offer

Notre Dame Catholic Sixth Form College is fully committed in continuing to deliver the curriculum through remote teaching. This will be done using a combination of live lessons and screen casting, using Microsoft Teams as the virtual learning platform. All students will follow their normal timetable; attendance on remote learning is expected to be 100% and attendance will be tracked closely. Assessment for learning will continue in the form of homework and assignment submissions and may also include the use of NEARPOD and other apps to monitor progress. All students are expected to continue to adhere to the Classroom Code of Conduct in order to ensure the best possible learning environment. Students who are vulnerable (this includes students who are unable to access remote learning from home) or whose parent/carer are a critical worker can attend College and will be directed to the library to access their streamed lesson. (To secure a place, students should email keyworkers@notredamecoll.ac.uk stating the criteria under which they fall. We will then respond to your email with further details).

The Learning Support Department will continue to work with SEND students and ensure they have the necessary support to access the curriculum either remotely, or physically within the department.
