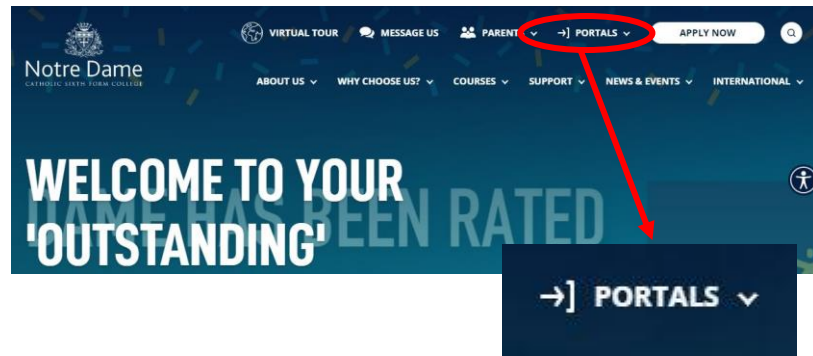

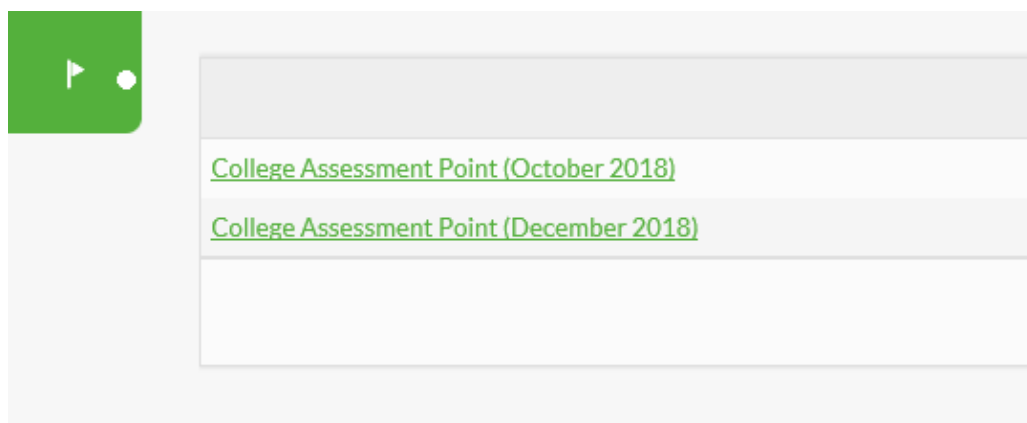

⁺ Students undertake three CAP assessments per year at Notre Dame. These are rigorous assessments in line with exam board expectations. CAP results are used to gauge progress against target grades, which are set based on their GCSE achievement.

⁺⁺ The grades displayed for College Assessment Points depend on the qualification taken:
 A Level = A-E, Vocational (BTEC or CTEC= Dist*, - Pass (D*, D, M, P) and Level 2 (GCSE etc.) = 9-1.
